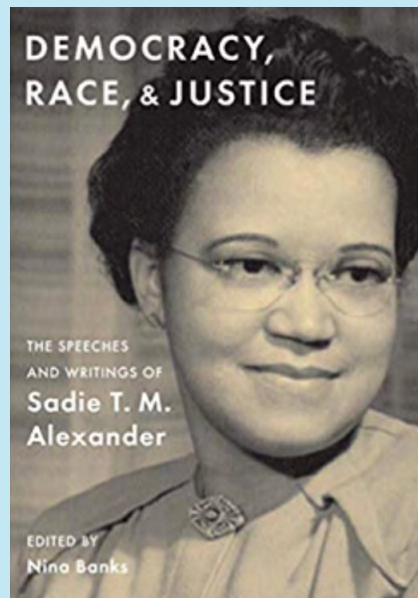
Speeches of Civil Rights Activist Whose Economics Career Was Thwarted by Discrimination to Be Published on the 100th Anniversary of Her Doctorate
